

When people are being racist to you, it's all you can think about. It's really hard to concentrate on learning in school when it's constantly on your mind.

I did tell the teachers about it, but they didn't really help. We didn't learn about racism, or really do any work on people from different backgrounds in school. If we had then maybe they wouldn't have been so nasty to me.

I told my mum and she got in touch with Show Racism the Red Card who really helped change things for me.

Since the workshop I am much more confident with myself now and I feel I can handle it better when people are racist to me.


