Who are we?

We are a group of young people aged 11-18 who meet in Leeds city centre between 6:30 and 8:30 every two weeks.

The group is supported by youth workers from the city centre team and provides a safe space for peer support, advice and guidance to young people that identify as lesbian, gay, bisexual or are questioning their sexuality.

What our group has to offer...

An opportunity to take part in youth work activities and have fun!

A chance to meet new people, who are in a similar situation.

You can learn new things within the group, such as about LGBTQ events & celebrations, how to look after yourself and keep yourself safe, get information about sexual health & relationships, education & training and so much more.

We can offer advice on how to come out to family and friends and how to get the right support you need.

The young people who attend are able to socialise freely within the group and are not forced to come to every session, it's a voluntary group.

The youth workers can also support you to access more specialist services if you want them to.

Within the group we have a confidentiality policy where the personal aspects of the young person's life is kept between the young person and youth workers.

It's up to the young person to share anything with others within the group if they feel they want to.

The Youth Workers respect that you expect confidentiality and that is what you'll will get unless they think you or someone else might be at significant risk of harm.
